All Medicare-covered and Medicaid-covered services are provided by Mount Sinai Eldercare if authorized by your care team. This includes but is not limited to:

- Adult day care center
- Preventive medical care
- Primary and specialty medical care
- Rehabilitation and therapy care
- Nursing support
- Social services
- Medications
- Diagnostic tests (laboratory and imaging)
- Nutritional counseling and meals
- Home care services
- Transportation to and from the center and medical appointments

ENROLLMENT CRITERIA

Enrollment in this program is voluntary. You qualify for Mount Sinai Eldercare if you:

- Are 55 years or older
- Need nursing home level care as determined by the state of Florida
- Can live safely in the community at the time of enrollment
- Live in Mount Sinai Eldercare's service area

ELDERCARE COSTS

What you pay for PACE depends on your eligibility under Medicare and Medicaid:

- If you are eligible for Medicaid, or dually eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid, you will not pay a monthly premium for PACE
- If you do not qualify for Medicaid, but you have Medicare, you will be charged a monthly premium for PACE
- If you do not have Medicare or Medicaid, you can pay for PACE privately

Enrolled participants will receive all health care services, including primary care and specialist physician services, from Mount Sinai Eldercare or from providers authorized by Mount Sinai Eldercare (with the exception of emergency services). There is no deductible or copayment for any drug, service, or care approved by your health care team. You may be fully and personally liable for the cost of unauthorized or out-of PACE program agreement services.



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
