

- Expanded women's and neonatal services can support higher acuity cases that often come with more complex reimbursement and deeper patient relationships.
  - Freestanding emergency rooms and outpatient clinics may help HCA keep patients inside its system rather than losing them to independent centers or rival chains.
  - Analysts have flagged policy and reimbursement changes, including Medicaid related shifts and tax credit expirations, as key risks that could affect the returns on new facilities.
  - Building and staffing new centers can increase fixed costs, so any slowdown in local demand or shifts to competitors could pressure margins.
