Mount Sinai Medical Center Named One of the Nation's Most Trusted Health System Brands

Mount Sinai ranks in the top 10 nationally in Monigle's 2026 Humanizing Brand Experience report, alongside Mayo Clinic and Johns Hopkins

MIAMI BEACH, FL — MAY, 28, 2026 — Mount Sinai Medical Center has been named one of the 20 most trusted health system brands in the country, ranking ninth nationally, in Monigle's 2026 Humanizing Brand Experience report, one of the most comprehensive studies of healthcare consumer sentiment in the United States.

The recognition comes from Monigle's annual study, which examined trust, engagement, compassion, and healthcare consumer sentiment among U.S. healthcare consumers. Mount Sinai stands among a small group of nationally recognized names including Mayo Clinic and Johns Hopkins Medicine.

"Patients don't give trust to institutions. They give it to people, often in the hardest moment of their lives," said Gino R. Santorio, President and Chief Executive Officer of Mount Sinai Medical Center. "To be named among the most trusted health systems in the country is a testament to the people who work here, in every role, who are showing extraordinary compassion and commitment in moments most of us never see. That is true honor and recognition, and something we are extremely proud of.

More than ever, where consumers choose to receive care comes down to trust. One in four consumers say they have switched providers after losing it, a pattern that holds across every generation and region. A place in the national top 10 reflects something only the daily experience of care can earn.

"Trust is built quietly," said Dr. Alon Weizer, Chief Medical Officer of Mount Sinai Medical Center. "It is built when a patient is frightened in the middle of the night, when a family is processing news they did not expect, when someone simply needs to be heard before they are treated. That is what our physicians, nurses, and care teams do on every shift, in every unit, with the greatest expertise. This recognition belongs to them."

The recognition comes during a period of significant expansion for Mount Sinai Medical Center. The institution recently opened the Braman Comprehensive Cancer Center, a major investment in cancer care capacity for South Florida, and earlier this year was designated a Cancer Center of Excellence by the Florida Department of Health. Mount Sinai has also been named to Healthgrades' America's 100 Best Hospitals, an honor that places it in the top 2% of hospitals in the nation. With 14 facilities serving Miami-Dade and Monroe Counties, Mount Sinai is bringing the standard of care that earned its national trust ranking closer to more of the people it serves.
